*DEFENDANT, BEING RELEASED ON HIS OWN RECOGNIZANCE, AGREES THAT:

(a) He will appear at all times and places as ordered by the Court or magistrate releasing him and as ordered by any Court in which, or an magistrate before whom, the charge is subsequently pending. (b) If he fails to so appear and is apprehended outside the State of California, he waives extradition. (c) Any Court or magistrate of competent jurisdiction may revoke this order of release and either return him to custody or require that he give bail or other assurance of his appearance as provided in Part 2, Title 10, Chapter 1 of the Penal Code. (d) If he willfully fails to appear at a scheduled court appearance, he may be charged with the additional charge of Failure to Appear (Section 1320 P.C.). If released on own recognizance on a misdemeanor charge, failure to appear may result in an additional penalty of six months in jail and a one thousand dollar (\$1,000) fine. If released on own recognizance on a felony charge, failure to appear may result in a fine not exceeding five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or by imprisonment pursuant to Section 1170(h) PC, or in the county jail for not more than one year, or by both the fine and imprisonment.
