IT IS ALLEGED THAT THE DEFENDANT WAS IN POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA FOR SALE. ON JULY 24, 2012, LOS ANGELES POLICE OFFICERS SERVED A SEARCH WARRANT IN CALIFORNIA AT _____ AT THE _____ HILLS, THE OFFICERS ENTERED THE UNLOCKED BUSINESS DURING NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS, IDENTIFIED THEMSELVES, AND ASKED IF THEY COULD CONDUCT A SEARCH WARRANT SERVICE. THE OFFICERS DETAINED FIVE OCCUPANTS INSIDE TO THE GROUND. THE DEFENDANT RANDOLPH _____ WAS THE LISTED OWNER/PERMIT HOLDER FOR THE LOCATION. HE WAS THE SOLE OCCUPANT IN A ROOM FROM WHICH OFFICERS RECOVERED FROM A DESK TWO SMALL BAGS OF MARIJUANA AND A DIGITAL SCALE.

THE OFFICERS CONTINUED THEIR SEARCH, AND RECOVERED EIGHT SMALLER BAGS FROM WITHIN A LARGE PLASTIC BAG. FROM A CLOSET A LARGE BAGGIE FILLED WITH MARIJUANA WAS RECOVERED. A FLOOR SAFE WAS FOUND AND OPEN WITH A KEY RECOVERED FROM WITHIN THE ROOM. THE SAFE CONTAINED \$1,925 IN UNITED STATES CURRENCY AND WHAT APPEARED TO BE PAY/OWE INFORMATION/RECORD KEEPING OF DRUG SALES TRANSACTIONS. TWO IDENTIFICATION CARDS IN _____ NAME WERE ALSO RECOVERED FROM THE SAFE.



BASED ON THE EVIDENCE INCLUDING BAGGIES, A SCALE, PAY AND OWE INFORMATION, UNITED STATES CURRENCY, AND MARIJUANA RECOVERED AT THE LOCATION, THE DEFENDANT WAS ARRESTED FOR VIOLATION OF 11359 HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE. SUBSEQUENT LABORATORY ANALYST REVEALED ONE PLASTIC BAG CONTAINING 208.9 GRAMS TESTED POSITIVE TEST FOR MARIJUANA AND A SECOND BAG CONTAINING 28.60 GRAMS OF A LEAFY GREEN SUBSTANCE ALSO TESTED POSITIVE FOR MARIJUANA.

EVALUATION

THIS -YEAR-OLD DEFENDANT IS NOT A STRANGER TO THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM. THE DEFENDANT ARRESTS AND CONVICTIONS CONSISTS OF POSSESSION OF 28.5 GRMS OR LESS OF MARIJUANA, BATTERY, DISCHARGING OF A FIREARM IN A NEGLIGENT MANNER, AND BURGLARY. HE HAS TWO FELONY CONVICTIONS ON HIS PRIOR CRIMINAL RECORD AND IS NOT LEGALLY ELIGIBLE FOR A GRANT OF FORMAL PROBATION. IN THE INSTANT MATTER, THE DEFENDANT WAS FOUND TO BE IN POSSESSION FOR SALES OF MARIJUANA. AT THIS TIME, A STATE PRISON SENTENCE IS WARRANTED.
